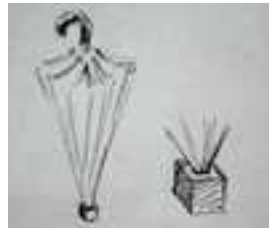
1. Observation



2. Extendable Umbrella: Height is adjustable so don't have to squeeze and bump into other umbrellas when passing through a crowd.



3. Standing Umbrella



4. 2 people Umbrella: elongated center/middle region



5. Adjustable Umbrella – The degree to which the umbrella opens can be adjusted to fit into allowed space. For example, in a crowd of people with umbrellas, the umbrella can be adjusted to open closer to the body to accommodate space and allow for easy maneuvering.

6. Umbrella Hook: Umbrella with a hook at the end that can be secured to an umbrella holder in public spaces. It is not as secure as a physical lock but more convenient and increases discouragement from being taken.



7. Parent friendly umbrella: Allows parents to hold the handle of the umbrella for small children where the handle is on the top rather than the traditionally on the underside of the umbrella covering. Covering is made of plastic enabling the parent to see through and supervise

8. Umbrella Calendar/organizer: Surface of open umbrella sectioned into grid for dividing month, date, and for taking notes.

9. Umbrella Cam: The round handle of umbrella contains 360 degrees camera capability. Good for both good and bad weather. Pressing bottom button under the handle turns the camera on and a double press then takes the picture.

10. Magnate Umbrella: Open umbrella with handle position on the top sucks up coins, paper clip, needles on the ground.

11. Umbrella Friend: A sensor to which friends' umbrella can be added and when the friend is close, umbrella will signal the owner with blinking light.

12. Umbrella Holder: umbrella flipped up-side-down, divided into sections, serving as organizer for light weight objects such as paper and desk stationeries.

13. Motorcycle umbrella hat: helmet designed with curves floating out from the center

14. Dispensable umbrella: The concept stems from origami with the idea that people can fold their own umbrella for real use using a sturdy material (wax paper) which can be easily be accessible.

15. Floating umbrella: Umbrella that has no handles and stays afloat on top of a person's head and is controlled by a tech device attached to a person's wrist or clothes. It calculates distance between the umbrella and height of the person and signal from the device will allow umbrella to follow the person's motions and position.

16. Solar umbrella: Solar panel on top of umbrella will provide the source of energy to plug in devices that can be charged through available USB ports at the bottom of the handle. MP3 players and cell phones can be plugged in at the bottom of the umbrella, saving battery.

17. Unsymmetrical Umbrella: Umbrella with one side longer than the rest for coverage. Can be faced to turn toward the direction where water is blown toward the body due to

wind.

18. Umbrella covers to middle of body so all of upper body is well sheltered and one side is fashioned in clear plastic to enable clear vision.

19. Night-friendly umbrellas: The covering of the umbrella is made or coated with material that will glow in the dark for pedestrian safety.

Iron Umbrella: Manufactured using heavier materials that can serve as a in conspicuous self-protection device and also as weight training.

20. H2O-Filter Umbrella: Concave Umbrella that acts as water collection and water is filtered as it passes through the handle section.

21. GPS Umbrella: GPS device installed on umbrella, enable checking direction while walking

Umbrella Shelter: Using the shape and material of umbrella to create houses for small animals

22. Blind Umbrella Can: Capable of detecting motion in front of a person and send vibration when there are hindrances.

23. Umbrella shirt: shape of the clothes made from water proof material and curve outward like an open umbrella

24. Umbrella symbolization: Used a blue umbrella symbol for men's restroom sign and red umbrella for women's restroom

25. Umbrella Zapper: Used as a defense weapon when attacked.
